How Would NNU Dues Reduce Your Take-Home Pay?

NNU charges 2.2 times your base hourly wage rate every month up to a maximum of \$170.22 per month.



That means dues could be up to \$6,128 over a typical 3-year contract



That is equal to what you would pay for utility bills (water, gas, electricity) for three years
